Sir; I submitted a formal complaint with the Syracuse office (W. Thurlow) late last month, yet they haven't responded with a formal notice of receipt. I called the office, but his secretary stated they couldn't give me any type of receipt of my complaint. This complaint concerns my son's 1999 murder, and how the extremely corrupt court system in Cayuga County manipulated the case with fraudulent claims of rape. His murderer received a six-year prison sentence for what should have been a Murder 1 trial after agreeing to a fraud-based "EED" plea bargain, and is due to be released in May, 2005. I met you in October, 2000 at an informal social held at then-mayor Carnicelli's house, and have been trying to follow your advice as how to pursue this case. Please, would you check with the Syracuse office and see what, if anything, is happening. If I don't hear anything soon I will be forced to post the entire complaint on the Internet, and I would not want to interfere with any ongoing investigations.
